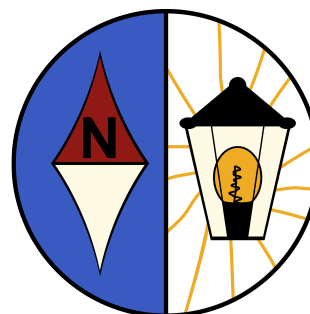
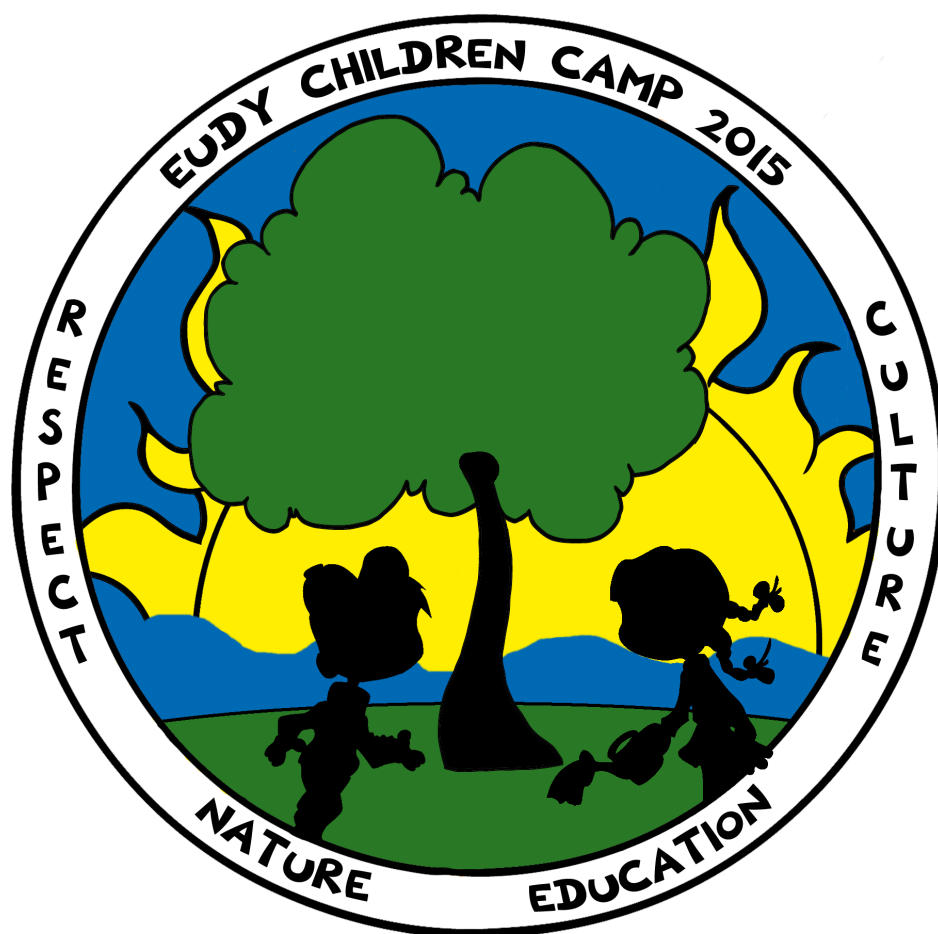


FIRST ANNOUNCEMENT

November 2014



This is the first announcement of the EUDY Children Camp 2015 for children, from 9 till 12 years old. In this news bulletin you will read the first informations about the camp which will be held in Bad Malente, Germany. This is in the north of Germany, about 80 km away from Hamburg airport.

EUDY

The European Union of the Deaf Youth is a European non-profit making organisation whose membership comprises Youth National Associations of Deaf and Youth Sections of National Associations of Deaf people in Europe. Established in 1987, EUDY is the only organisation representing the interests of Deaf Young Europeans in Europe. Currently, EUDY has 26 Full members, from Iceland to Turkey and from Spain to Finland. We are aiming to get stronger and bigger by having all member states of the Council of Europe included in EUDY and together our voice will be stronger across Europe and beyond.

DGJ

DGJ is a youth association of Germany (YNAD) and has many small youth associations in the whole of Germany. They support of the social, cultural and political participating of the children and young people in the form of different contributions to the self-realisation and development of the personality of young deaf people. Representation of interests of deaf young people during the public and private places at the national level. Cooperation with the other national and international associations who have also put the support and support of deaf and partially deaf youngsters to the aim to themselves. The aim of the YNAD is equal rights with all youngsters: Cohumanity with dignity, assistance to the community and culture of the deaf and a backup of the communication free of barrier in German sign language (DGS).

Nordlicht

Nordlicht is the second oldest youth association in Germany and has cofounded the German deaf youth with two other associations in 2004. They have the aim, that to guarantee the children and youngsters in region Hamburg and surroundings an extracurricular education in different forms. They concern the youngsters of from 6 to 27 years and have a good network with different associations in Hamburg. They have aimed that the educational deficits of the youngsters are covered very completely and the inclusion of all youngsters nearly realise. Cultural and pedagogic interest of the youngsters speak also directly to the youngsters at school time and after it, too.

GOC

We, the leader of German organizer committee (GOC), are glad very much that we may take over the the responsibility for the magnificently European child camp in Germany. We want sign to all children and the responsible persons of all countries which want to cause with Council of Europe 'COE' welcome and we with this camp that the children can build up early a European network by her exchange in areas: Culture, activities and teamwork.

Bad Malente

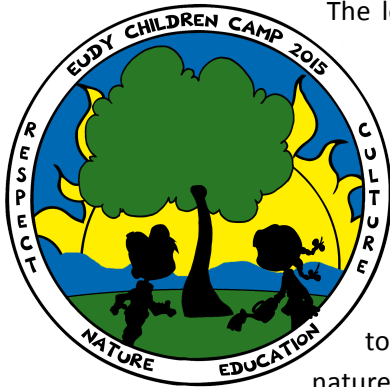

Theme and logo



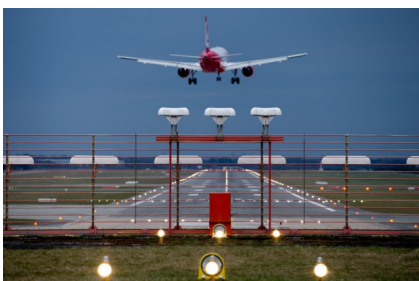

Travel information

There are many ways getting to Germany: by air, rail, bus, ferry, and car. If you plan to get here by air, then please make your ticket to HAMBURG AIRPORT, Hamburg, Germany. We will provide free transportation from Airport to Bad Malente. We are planning, that the last bus leave airport at 15 clock. So be sure you will arrive at least at 14:00



Your travel information must be stated on the schedule and send to us, as soon you know your arrival and departure times but at least one month before the camp, before 01th of June, so we can arrange your transport to the camp.

Any different way of transport is on your own costs and responsibilities. For more information how to travel in Germany, please don't hesitate to contact us.

Alcohol and drug policy

Neither alcohol nor drugs are allowed during the camp days - Neither by the participants nor by the leaders. If we notice any use of such things, you will be asked to leave the camp.

Medical needs

If you have, any medical needs then please state on the registration form. In order to ensure your prescriptive medicine or syringes can be brought to Germany a prescription from your doctor must be brought along with you, to be shown to the customs prior to arrival.

Insurance

Personal travel insurance must be prepared before entering Germany. If something should happen to you during you stay, we will assist you and your leader as best as possible. If you need to change your return ticket due illness your travel insurance should cover this.

Vaccinates

In general, there are no vaccinates needed

Camp Fees

The EUDY guidelines requires that there is a lower price for the developing countries than for the developed ones.

For the developed countries: € 450

For the developing countries: € 350

The camp fee includes accommodation, meals and activities for the whole week. As before mentioned all travel expenses are on your own.

At this moment we are in **business to get camp fees lower**. For now we ask you to make over your camp fee by may 1st at the latest.
