Nordic Youth Camp 2022

Jørpeland, Rogaland, Norway

We in the NUL-committee on behalf of the Norges Døveforbunds Ungdom are pleased to announce that the Nordic Youth Camp, NUL, will be at Preikestolen BaseCamp which is in Jørpeland in Rogaland County. The same county as the Deaf Nordic Culture Festival will take place right after the camp!

Preikestolen BaseCamp is located next to the famous tourist destination, Preikestolen, with approx. an hour's walk surrounded by the beautiful mountain nature around it. The campsite itself is surrounded by forest and lake. The address of the campsite is Preikestolvegen 521, 4105 Jørpeland. We will drive shared bus from Stavanger Bus Terminal to camp site.



«Psykt Nordisk!»

Wordplay with “psykt” where it is sewn with Norwegian words - psykisk and sykt. Psykisk is related to “psykisk helse” which is translated to “mental health”. Sykt can be translated as something in amazement like as “Det er sykt bra! – It’s damn good!” or “Det er sykt! – That’s sick!” (Like as someone did something unbelievable). Nordisk is Nordic in Norwegian.

Becomes the motto for the camp after 2 long years of corona and closure, for many, life is transformed in many ways, and it became extra hard for some. At this camp, mental health will be the focus and together we will be stronger!

At the camp there will also be many fun, problem-solving and self-mastering activities from morning to night!

All Nordic countries send a maximum of 20 participants each aged 18-30 years + 1 leader. The camp is for deaf and hard of hearing young people who are sign language-users.
